



# GLOBAL COST OF CYBERCRIME

## \$10 - \$12 billion

is the estimated annual loss from cybercrime targeting IP in the U.S.

## +\$8 billion

a year was lost to Internet crime in Brazil in 2015; this happened to be the No.1 economic crime in the country.



## \$3 billion

was the estimated economic damages caused by cybercrime in Mexico in 2016.

## +\$64 billion

per year was spent on the damages of the cybercrime that affected more than half of all German companies in 2016.

## \$17 million in cash

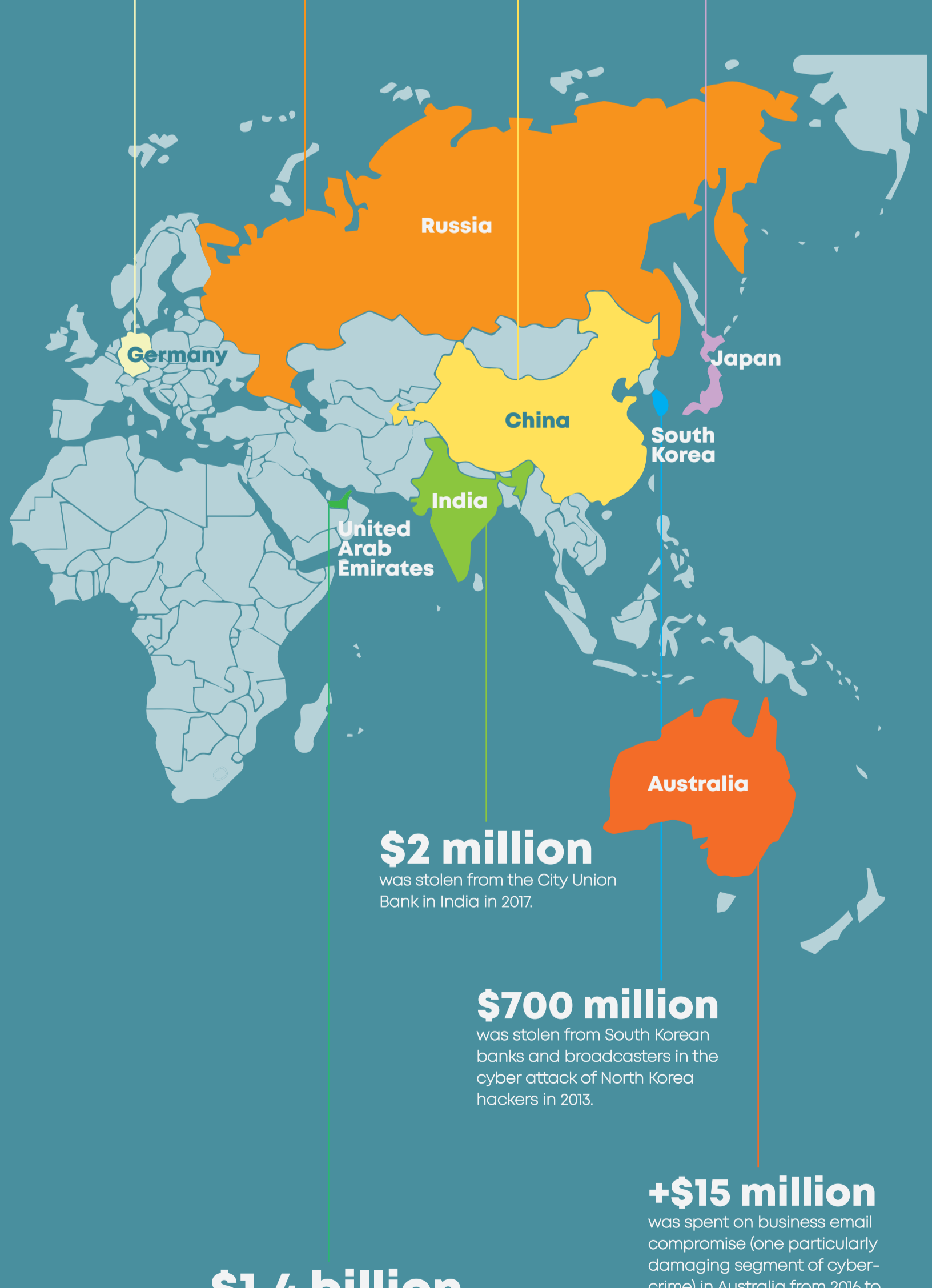
was stolen from 1700 ATM across Japan in 2015 from using 3000 stolen accounts at a South African bank.

## \$6 million

was stolen from a Russian bank in an attack using the SWIFT international payments messaging system in 2017.

## + \$13.8 billion

was the cost of the damage relating to data loss, identity thief and fraud caused by the underground cybercrime in China in 2017.



## \$1.4 billion

per year is the estimated cost of cybercrime in United Arab Emirates.

## \$2 million

was stolen from the City Union Bank in India in 2017.

## \$700 million

was stolen from South Korean banks and broadcasters in the cyber attack of North Korea hackers in 2013.

## +\$15 million

was spent on business email compromising (one particularly damaging segment of cybercrime) in Australia from 2016 to 2017.
